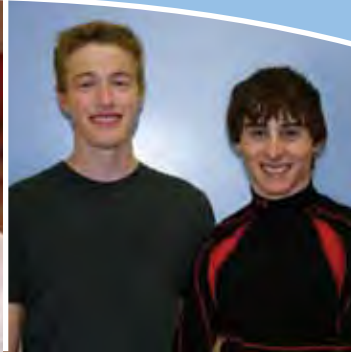




athletic competition • community service • social events • cultural programs

- They'll stay with 350 Jewish host families who will "adopt" them for the week and make them a part of their family and our community.
- They'll spend evenings in activities; socializing, having fun and forging Jewish friendships that will last a lifetime.
- They'll devote one day to community service.
- They'll learn about the "Rachmanus" (compassion) rule of sportsmanship and honor the eleven Israeli Olympians killed by terrorists at the 1972 Olympic Games.
- They'll trade t-shirts, pins, banners, athletic bags, uniforms, and dozens of other "mementos" of the JCC Maccabi Games in Omaha.
- They, along with their adult coaches and visiting parents and guests, will leave Omaha knowing we are the "best" of host cities and we did everything at the highest level to make their experience here **extraordinary!**
