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Tuition is due in advance, on the 1st of the month by credit card on file or bank draft. Accounts must be kept current and the member of record is ultimately responsible for payment of all charges. Only current members of the Jewish Community Center in good standing are eligible to enroll their children in the Early Learning Center. JCC Membership must be maintained throughout the year. 30 day notice is required for withdrawal from our program. There are no fee reductions for absences, family vacations or holidays.

#### **EMERGENCIES** INITIAL

In case of emergency, a physician and or medical facility of the JCC's choosing is authorized to administer emergency medical treatment necessary to ensure the health of the child. Medical forms are required before attendance is permitted.

#### PARENT PERMISSION FORM INITIAL

As the parent/legal guardian of the child/children listed on the registration form and those that may not be listed at the time of joining, I take full responsibility for the actions of the child/children and any and all minor guest(s) of my child. (I have signed this parent permission form and understand that I am fully responsible for their actions.) I hereby give permission for my child(ren) to participate in all ELC/JCC activities. In the event that I cannot be reached, I hereby give permission to the ELC/JCC to act on my behalf to have medical treatment administrated to my child(ren) in the event of an emergency. I understand that I will be fully and directly responsible for the cost of medical attention. I further understand that the ELC/JCC reserves the right to restrict or to remove persons from activities when appropriate.

### Jewish Federation / Community Information \_

I give my permission for my/my child's information to be shared with Jewish Federation of Omaha / Jewish community entities.

All members are required to carry a JCC membership card while at the ELC. Use of card is necessary to enter the facility. Non-transferable, photo ID membership cards are issued to all Omaha JCC members age 7 and older. (Membership card replacement fee is \$10)

#### ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS

**Criminal History:** The applicant acknowledges that it is the policy of the Omaha JCC to deny membership to any individual convicted of a sexual offense.

**Cell Phone/Video Taping:** Due to advances in video equipment and telephone video technology, and for the safety and security of our members and guests, any and all video equipment may not be used in locker rooms, dressing areas, shower areas, restrooms, or other areas generally deemed to be "private" within JCC facilities.
